

What is Buddy Art?

Buddy Art is a program designed to provide art activities for children with special needs and/or disabilities. The program is free and is sponsored by the **Williamsburg Contemporary Art Center** in cooperation with W&M Campus Buddies (student volunteers from the College of William & Mary), and the James City County Parks & Recreation department.

A variety of art activities are offered based on the ages, ability levels, and interests of the participating children.

Each child is assigned a volunteer "Buddy" to work with them one-on-one, helping them to explore the materials, and replenishing their supplies as needed. Participants may stay in one area or explore multiple activities during the one-hour class period.



There are generally five art stations including activities such as Finger-painting, Clay (air-drying clay), Collage (cutting or tearing & pasting colored/textured papers and other objects), Drawing (crayons; markers; pastels; colored pencils; drawing pencils), Stamping (with stamps relating to the theme), Easel Painting (tempera), Carpentry, and a Puppet Theatre. Special projects might include body-tracings for self-portraits or printmaking projects such as leaf-printing.

Parents are invited to participate with their child or to simply observe. Buddies are assigned to each child regardless of the parent's participation so that the parent can share the activity without having to be responsible for managing the art materials and set-up.

The Buddy Art program is offered each Fall & Spring. Six classes are scheduled during William & Mary' Fall & Spring academic terms with student volunteers serving as "Buddies" to the kids.

Classes meet from 3:00 to 4:00 p.m. in Rooms A&B at the JCC Rec Center, 5301 Longhill Road, Williamsburg. **Class dates for the Fall 2018 session are Saturdays, September 15, 22, October 6, 27, and November 3, 10. The Spring 2019 session dates are Saturdays, February 2, 9, 16, 23, March 16, 23**
